TEN STOREYS HIGH release their debut album – *The Thrill Of The Fall*

Ten Storeys high are a semi-acoustic, four-piece band based in Edinburgh.

They are Ewan Beck (bass), Callum Maguire (vocals), Steve Scott (guitar) and Colin Usher (drums).

A Brief History

The line-up of Ten Storeys High was completed in early 2007. A frantic period of song writing followed and the submission of a rough demo led to a successful series of gigs supporting The Proclaimers around Scotland in June 2007. A debut **single *Good Things*** was released on Sweet Day Records to coincide with the tour and received airplay on **Radio Scotland, XFM and Forth 1 FM** while the pre-release album track ***Home is Where the Heart Lies*** has been included in a recent **iTunes** compilation. More song writing ensued culminating in the band recording their first album *The Thrill of the Fall*.

The Album

The Thrill of the Fall features eleven new, self-penned tracks featuring contributions from guest musicians Stevie Christie (Botany 5, Niki King) and Mike Hall (The Lost Soul Band, ScubaZ). Influences range from **Jacque Brel, Nina Simone** and **Scott Walker** through to **Mercury Rev, Nick Cave** and **Mark Lanegan**. The idea is to combine strong song writing with an eclectic range of styles while retaining a cohesive, distinctive, acoustic band sound. What Happens Next

Over the next few weeks the band will be promoting the album with a short series of intimate gigs around central Scotland including an **album launch** night at **Edinburgh's Voodoo Rooms on Friday 27 June**. You are of course, invited.
